PARENTS DAY OUT

Licensed by the Office of Child Care of the Maryland State Department of Education

This program is for our morning preschool children who may occasionally need to stay at school for extra time. Parents Day Out is tailored to provide a nurturing environment for children whose parents require additional care for them.

The PDO fees will be billed monthly.

All children enrolled in the Preschool are automatically eligible to attend Parents Day Out with no additional registration fee.

7:30-9:00am - \$18/day 8:15-9:00am - \$9/day

Afternoon:

11:45-1:00 - \$18/day 11:45-3:00 - \$27/day The Towson Presbyterian Preschool was established in 1958 to serve the needs of the community by providing quality programs for children aged 2 to 4 years old.

As a school licensed and accredited by the Maryland State Department of Education, we firmly believe that early childhood experiences are crucial for every child. To ensure that children's needs are met, we place a strong emphasis on developmental theory. TPP's curriculum, particularly its focus on play and the arts, equips students with the skills they need to become lifelong learners. Through both free and guided play, children not only learn content but also critical thinking, collaboration, creative innovation, communication, and confidence.

It is our school's policy not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or ethnicity. Our staff is carefully selected, with teachers holding bachelor's degrees and qualifications in Early Childhood Education, while other staff members meet the requirements of the Office of Child Care of the Maryland State Department of Education.

Maintaining small class sizes is a vital feature at TPP. Typically, we have nine children in our two-year old preschool classes, nine to twelve in our three-year old preschool classes and no more than sixteen in our four-year old preschool classes. Each classroom group consists of a Lead Teacher and an Assistant Teacher.

The governing body responsible for determining policies, rates and programs is the Board of Directors. The Director is responsible for implementing these policies and programs while maintaining the educational quality of the school.

MORNING PRESCHOOL PROGRAM 8:45AM-11:45AM

Our curriculum is carefully planned to develop positive attitudes of self-worth, trust in others, and enthusiasm for learning. The program offers a variety of experiences for each child to grow not only intellectually but physically, socially, and emotionally. The Preschool curriculum begins promptly at 9:00AM, and drop-off is between 8:45AM and 9:00AM. Preschool dismissal begins at 11:30AM through 11:45AM.

MORNING PRESCHOOL PROGRAM WITH EXTENDED DAY 7:30AM-5:30PM

The Full Time Program allows children to arrive at school as early as 7:30AM and stay until 5:30PM. Children engage in free play until 8:30AM when they transition into their morning preschool classes. At 11:30AM, the children have extra playground time, and lunch begins at 12:20PM (You provide the lunch). Rest time starts at 1:00PM. After rest, there is a snack, and then the children have more active play and organized activities to finish their day. In this program, we offer a warm enriching environment. Children are grouped flexibly according to their needs and interests, with a change of pace and a change of faces from the morning preschool.
